Here are some general details that will give us a better understanding of this GREAT miracle:

- There were 5,000 men plus women and children that were not numbered.
- This story took place right after the beheading of John the Baptist.
- These people followed Jesus into a remote spot because they heard he would be in the area and they wanted to hear Him speak.
- The famous story of Peter walking on water took place directly after this miracle.

From this amazing story of the feeding of 5000, I'd like to share three noticeable ingredients that we see that were necessary for this MIRACLE to take place.

- Throughout the New Testament we can find the phrase "And Jesus was moved with compassion."
- We serve a very compassionate God!
- Notice that the Disciple wanted to send them away
- God knows our greatest need is spiritual, and His compassion wants us to have that need met.
