• True spiritual maturity is the ability to recognize what is right and what is wrong.

Hebrews 5:13-14 For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. 14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

1. A Babe

1 Pet 2:2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby.

- A babe is one that needs to be fed and nourished.
- The main goal for a baby Christian is growth.

2. A Child

1 Corinthians 14:20 Brethren, be not children in understanding: howbeit in malice be ye children, but in understanding be men.

1 John 2:1a My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not ...

- A child is one that needs to be trained.
- The main goal for a child is learning the fear of the Lord.

3. A Son

1 John 3:2-3 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. 3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

- The son is one who is in the likeness of his father.
- The spiritual goal is to demonstrate God's righteousness in his life.

4. A Disciple

John 8:31-32 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; 32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

 A disciple is one who embraces the instruction given to him and makes it his rule of conduct.

CHARACTERISTICS OF THIS LEVEL:

a. They will experience rejection.

Matthew 10:14 And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear your words, when ye depart out of that house or city, shake off the dust of your feet.

h. God's word lives in them.

John 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

c. The bear spiritual fruit in their lives.

John 15:8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.

d. They accept the requirements of discipleship.

Luke 14:26-27, 33 If any man come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple. 27 And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple. 33 So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.

• The spiritual goal is to know God's truth and experience freedom in life.
